Our Non-Profit Addresses Housing and Food Insecurity



PUSH Ministry is a Community Development Corporation dedicated to providing resources to underserved communities through donation drives, home building and rehabilitation in addition to providing affordable housing.

We serve Metro Atlanta and parts of rural Georgia, including but not limited to: Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, Douglas, Fayette, Forsyth, Fulton, Gwinnett, Henry and Rockdale counties, and the city of Atlanta.

According to ARC's population forecasts, the 10-county region will add more than 2.9 million people by 2050, bringing the population to 8.6 million. A majority of the population – nearly 70 percent – is now made up of racial and ethnic minority groups, a figure that is expected to increase over time. – Atlanta Regional Commission

PUSH Ministry provides economic recovery training through financial literacy partnerships. PUSH Ministry renovates homes in distressed areas through administration of HUD's HOME Rehabilitation Program and feeds the community through a partnership with Second Helpings Atlanta.

FEEDING OUR COMMUNITY

PUSH Ministry distributes over 4,000 lbs of food per week through a partnership with Second Helpings Atlanta and Publix Grocery store.

Second Helpings Atlanta is a nonprofit food rescue organization whose mission is to reduce hunger and food waste in the Metro Atlanta area by rescuing surplus food and distributing it to those in need.



PUSH Ministry is positioned as a leader in the community by collecting healthy food and donating it to those in need.

By giving quality food to charities, food banks and homeless shelters, we're feeding people, supporting our community, and saving that food from going to waste.



Their love for such service was coined "PUSH For Good" by team member, Erikka Bolding. At the PUSH for Good event PUSH utilized a \$2,000 grant from GreyStone Power Foundation to give away roughly 1,000 lbs worth of items, feeding over 50 families on Good Friday in Atlanta.

FOOD BANK

PUSH Ministry distributes over 4,000 lbs of food per week through a partnership with Second Helpings Atlanta. PUSH Ministry is positioned as a leader in the community by collecting unspoiled, healthy food and donating it to those in need. By giving quality food to charities, food banks and homeless shelters, we're feeding people, supporting our community, and saving that food from going to waste.

HOME BUILDING AND RENOVATION

The purpose of our program is to provide transitional housing services to low-income individuals on section 8. We acquire property in distressed areas, make renovations to the homes and then provide them as affordable housing options to those who are on government assistance. PUSH Ministry currently provides housing interventions in lower-income households through administration of the HUD's HOME Rehabilitation Program awarded by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs. PUSH Ministry provides the HOME Rehabilitation Program, which offers rehabilitation assistance to homeowners in the City of Atlanta based on the availability of funds, household income, the requests of the homeowner and the conditions of the home.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

PUSH Ministry was able to provide affordable home sharing spaces to families, vets, single mothers, mental health patients and senior citizens with low barriers to entry. PUSH Ministry was able to utilize multiple residential properties for Emergency Shelter and/or Rapid Rehousing during critical times for our country. PUSH Ministry provided homes for over 50 families.


